

Presentation Guidelines

ISSLR/FOGSL Conference

Oral Presentations

Twenty minutes is scheduled for each oral presentation, including the talk, questions and change-over time. Presenters should consequently speak for a maximum of 16 minutes to allow time for questions and changing over to the next speaker. Presentations should be in the English language. Please test your presentation to make sure that fonts are sufficiently large to be read from the back of a 15-m (45 ft) long room. At an international conference where there may be some language difficulties, having clear slides is particularly important.

Computers and projectors will be available in each session for PowerPoint presentations. You should upload your presentation from a memory stick (USB Flash Drive) or CD on the morning of your presentation. If you need other audio-visual aids, please contact Wayne Wurtsbaugh (wurts@cc.usu.edu).

Poster Presentations

Poster dimensions should not exceed 115 cm x 115 cm (3' 9" x 3' 9"). Size requirements must be strictly adhered to so they fit within the space assigned to them. If your poster exceeds these specifications, it may be subject to removal. Pins and display boards will be available.

The posters can be displayed from Monday morning through Friday at 15:00. Two specific poster sessions are scheduled on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. You should spend time at your poster during these periods to answer questions and discuss your work with other scientists.
